## Banff National Park

### **Canada Strong Pass**

Free admission and 25% off camping and overnight stays with Parks Canada is in effect from:

- December 12, 2025 to January 15, 2026
- June 19 to September 7, 2026

### **2026 fee adjustment**

Under the Service Fees Act, Parks Canada, among other federal departments and agencies, is required to automatically adjust its fees to accommodate inflation. Fees and pricing for Parks Canada administered places will increase on January 1, 2026.

**Senior** - Person 65 years of age or over

**Youth** - Person 6 to 17 years of age
