- Tour can be up to 3.5 hours
- A BBQ lunch is available for an additional \$15 per person. Lunch is served from 12:15-1:15 and includes a beef or veggie burger, pasta salad, carrots, a brownie, and juice/water. Please let us know if you would like to pre-book lunch!
- Light refreshments are also available for purchase on site, alternatively you can bring drinks and snacks to have in your vehicle for the end of your trip.
- Please note that the Kicking Horse is a glacier fed river and water levels fluctuate. As the season progresses, the rapids can change from Class 4 to Class 3.

Please bring:

A piece of photo ID, bathing suit (already on), a towel, underwear, a bag for your personal belongings which should be left in your vehicle, your own food and drink and any necessary medication that must come on the raft. Towels are available for purchase at the river base.

Restrictions:

Minimum age and weight to participate is 12 years and 90 lbs. Children may be weighed at our river base. All rafters are required to show ID and complete and sign a liability waiver to participate in the tour. Click [here](#) to view waiver. Please note that if you arrive late to the river base or miss your tour, there will be no refund. This tour needs a minimum of 12 people to operate. If we have not met minimum numbers, we will notify you 24 hours before tour time.

From Banff: Approx. 1 hour and 20 minutes

Do not go into the town of Golden as it is 20 mins passed our River Base.

Directions from Banff to Hydra River Guides Base:

- Travel WEST on the Trans Canada Highway (Hwy #1) past Banff and Lake Louise
- Approximately 20 minutes (29 km) after Field, you will see a sign - leaving Yoho National Park and some large Billboards on your left hand side.
- Slow down and take the next right exit off the highway, signposted for Beaverfoot Road and Hydra River Guides. Go through the underpass and turn left onto Beaverfoot Road (follow the Hydra signs) Travel straight on a small gravel road.
- Cross over the railway tracks and then over a bridge.
- Take the first right onto Kicking Horse Rd. Our raft site is the driveway on the right - past the red cabins (Chancellor Peak Chalets). Look for the Hydra River Guides sign.

From Golden, BC: Approx. 20 minutes to River Base (look for Beaverfoot Road exit)
